COVID-19 and **Protocol**









Keeping in mind the current healthcare context, the LOC for the SUDS Open Euro TriGames 2021 wants to welcome all delegations, judges, volunteers in the best possible conditions in terms of healthcare safety.

BEFORE YOUR ARRIVAL IN ITALY

- All delegation members will have to provide a negative COVID-19 PCR (Molecular) test carried out within 48 hours prior to their arrival in Italy.
- The aforementioned documents must be written in Italian or English.

ACCREDITATION

- We will be informing all delegations of the accreditation area or venue assigned to them. They will have to report to said place upon their arrival in Ferrara.
- All delegations must fill in a certification that the LOC will send within 30 days prior to their arrival in Italy.
- All delegation members must answer a self-evaluation questionnaire that the LOC will send within 30 days prior to their arrival in Italy.

DURING THE GAMES

General information

- According to Italian laws and regulations, the space to be kept between people while social distancing is 1 (one) metre.
- Alcohol-based hand sanitizer will be available throughout all the venues.
- The LOC will measure the temperature of every person at the entrance of each venue.
- Every person inside all venues will have to wear a face mask at all times. The rule doesn't apply to:
 - » Athletes during their own competitions
 - » Coaches during team sports matches (Basketball and Futsal)
- Access to the venues for guests, visitors and spectators will be dependent on the laws and regulations in place during the Games.



- A way of circulation will be determined for all movements inside the venues.
- The entrance and the exit will be from different points of each venue.
- The usage of changing rooms and showers will be dependent on the laws and regulations in place during the Games.
- Toilets will be cleaned and disinfected regularly.
- Posters, signage and other materials will be on display at all venues, in order to remind all participants of the safety measures in place.
- If someone shows symptoms typical of COVID-19, he or she will be isolated while waiting for the Healthcare Authorities to intervene.

Stands

- We will be designating a seating area for each delegation; we ask all delegations to occupy the same area during all of the Games.
- The same general rules concerning access to the venues will be in place for the stands.
- A way of circulation will be determined for passing between the stands and the track or field of play.

Pasti

Lunches and dinners will be served at the table. The delegations will eat their meals separately.

DURING THE COMPETITIONS/EVENTS

Warm-up phases

- Social distancing and health and safety regulations must be observed during the warm-up phases.
- Delegation staff members must wear a face mask during the warm-up phases.

Call rooms/areas

- Social distancing and health and safety regulations must be observed inside all call rooms/ areas
- Everyone must wear a face mask inside all call rooms/areas.



Results

- All results will be sent via e-mail to the delegations; they will also be published on the event website (www.eurotrigames2021.eu).
- The results will **NOT** be displayed inside the venues to avoid crowding.

Medal Ceremonies

- Social distancing and health and safety regulations must be observed during all medal ceremonies.
- We will be establishing a waiting area for the medal ceremonies in which social distancing must be observed at all times.
- The athletes must wear a face mask while on the podium; this includes photo opportunities.
- Medals will be presented to the athletes on a tray. Every athlete will have to collect his medal by himself.
- No physical contact of any kind will be allowed between the athletes and the representative presenting the medals.
- The athletes will be forbidden from congregating on a step of the podium.

Medical Service

- A medical service will be present for the whole duration of the Games.
- The LOC will designate a COVID Manager.
- First aid teams will be present for the whole duration of the Games.

Specific information for each sport will be sent out at a later date.

This protocol may be subject to changes in relation to updates in regulations issued by the Italian Ministry of Health and all other relevant authorities.

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
