Visas

Each participating national delegation is responsible for arranging for the necessary visas for their delegation.

If it needed, the LOC will issue a letter of invitation to participating national delegation. We ask you to inform us as soon as possible if you need to apply visas.

Eligibility and accreditation

All athletes entering the event should already be registered with the SUDS. Please visit the www.su-ds.org website for the SUDS Registration Policy. We ask you to send us a passport photo for each member of your delegation. The photos must adhere to the following requirements:

- JPEG format (.jpg, .jpeg extensions)
- Portrait passport format
- The background must be as homogeneous as possible
- The filename must be in the [Country]_ [Given name]_[Surname] .jpg format

The closing date for submitting SUDS Registration applications is 13 April 2026.

Medical service and health protocol

There will be a permanent medical service present during each competition day

Insurance

The Local Organising Committee ensures satisfactory arrangements in respect of public liability and professional indemnity. Participating member organisations are responsible for their own insurance requirement for travel, personal accident, liability and medical matters.

Entry deadlines

- Intention of Participation: 31 December 2025
- Entry by numbers and first 30% down payment: 28 February 2026
- Entry by names, competition forms, travel info and final payment: 30 April 2026

Bank transfer charges will be at the expense of the country.

Entry fees

This entry fee per person for all delegation members (athletes and officials) includes six nights accommodation, all meals (from lunch on June 13 to breakfast on June 19), transportation to and from Sofia airport, transportation to all competitions venues, training sessions and key events, and SUDS competition tax. This package is available for Athletics, Table Tennis, Tennis, Artistic Gymnastics and Rhythmic Gymnastics.

The entry fees per 1 person:

- € 930,00 per person for a double room accommodation
- € 1050,00 per person for a single room accommodation

The single rooms are subject to availability; therefore, we cannot guarantee we will be able to satisfy all requests for single rooms. Requests will be treated on a first come, first serve basis.
