ELIGIBILITY AND ACCREDITATION

All athletes entering the event should already be registered with the SU-DS. Please visit the www.su-ds.org website for the SU-DS Registration Policy. We ask you to send us a passport photo for each member of your delegation. The photos must adhere to the following requirements: • JPEG format (.jpg, .jpeg extensions) • Dimensions must be in a 1:1 ratio • The background must be as homogeneous as possible • The minimum resolution must be 600 x 600 px • The filename must be in the [Country]_[Surname]_[Given name].jpg format

INSURANCE

ENTRY DEADLINES

Entry by numbers and first 30% down payment: 30 April 2026

In case the event is cancelled for health/pandemic reasons, or if the Delegation withdraws its entry before or on 10 of June 2026, the Organization will keep 10% of the total entry fee; after that deadline, the Organization will keep 100% of the total entry fee.

Travels and transportation

Airport arrival

Volunteers will meet up with your team after you pass customs and guide you to the bus, it is about a 2,5-hour drive from Arlanda airport to the town of Lindesberg.

All accommodation options are within walking distances in Lindesberg, if you need assistance, please contact the LOC and we will provide you with transportation.

Departure

On the departure day the bus will take you back to Arlanda Airport depending on what time your flight departs.

Competition

The Judo competition, both individual and team, will be held at Lindesberg Arena. The individual competition will take place on Friday, 7 August 2026, and the Team competition on Saturday, 8 August 2026. Both competitions will be livestreamed on the Smoothcomp platform and available as pay-per-view.

Coaches and audience at home can in real time follow the judokas with live match order and results on the same platform.

Award ceremony will be held after the individual competition and then again after the team competition.
